

Dear Franklin Families:

As we approach the last week of school before our holiday season, please keep a few things in mind:

1. As per the handbook, during cold weather our students must remain in uniform. They can wear long sleeve shirts in navy, white or black under their uniform shirt with their Franklin jacket. Girls may wear navy, white or black tights under their skorts. There are no exceptions to the uniform policy.
2. You should have completed 4 hours of volunteer time by the end of the 2nd quarter. One way to complete your hours is through the Parent Booster Network.
