

Good evening parents,

We are so excited to start the year! Here are a few reminders for Monday:

1. Arrival: High School students must report to their Homeroom/Period 1 on Monday. Students cannot be dropped off any earlier than 7:15 am. An email will be sent tomorrow with the first period class location. The entire schedule can be viewed in PowerSchool this weekend. Middle school students can also see their schedules on PowerSchool if they did not pick it up during Meet & Greet last Tuesday. They should not be dropped off any earlier than 8:15 am. Maps will be provided upon arrival for those students who need it. If a student cannot access their schedule, they will report to the cafeteria.
2. PowerSchool: You should receive your PowerSchool Login Code by tomorrow in a separate email.
3. Dress Code: Students are required to wear their full uniforms on the first day of school. If the uniform has not arrived, students are required to wear navy blue pants and white polo shirts. They must carry in their pocket a copy of their proof of uniform purchase otherwise, they will be sent home for being out of uniform. Please note, PE uniforms will not be needed the first 3 days of school. Hair color must be natural. Please review the uniform requirements in the Parent Student Handbook on our website. You must print and sign the last two pages of the handbook for the Homeroom teacher. This will be due August 25th.
4. Transportation: You should have received a postcard or an email from A1A. If you just recently registered, please make arrangements for drop-off and pick-up until you receive the postcard. Students will need the card to board the bus. Any questions, please contact A1A. Their number is on our website.
5. Lunch: Please make sure to add money to your student's account before Monday. This is done online through our website.
6. Health forms: All new students should have turned in their health forms. 7th graders are required an additional vaccine.
7. Clubs: Registration for clubs will continue this week. Please check our website under Clubs & Activities.
8. Athletics: Soccer tryouts will be held the first week! Please see the attached flyer and consent form.
9. Open House: Mark your calendars! Open House is September 5-7. Please see attached flyer.
10. Dismissal: Dismissal procedures may be slightly different than last year due to student drivers. Please make sure to follow directions from our staff to ensure everyone's safety. We ask for your patience and kindness while everyone learns the norms and routines. Week 1 will certainly run slower as new families get adjusted to the Franklin Pass System. Please welcome them with your kindness.
